Federal 2 Standards The Minimum Safety and reporting 3 requirements for pipeline facilities and transportation of gas prescribed by the United States Department of Transportation in 4 Parts 191 and 192 of Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) as 5 amended through January 1, 2001 October 20, 1998, are adopted as 6 part of these rules.
