> Re: Request for Deferment of the initiation of show cause proceedings against OLS, Inc., Docket no. 010245 to allow newly retained regulatory counsel to review the matter and proffer a substantive settlement offer

Felecia, Dale and Staff:

Herewith the Helein Law Group, P.C. enters its appearance on behalf of OLS, Inc. ("OLS"). Further, we hereby respectfully request a deferment of the initiation of show cause proceedings against OLS in Docket no. 010245 for apparent violations of Rule 25-4.118 F.A.C. and Rule 25-4.0161 F.A.C. We ask for deferment to, at least, the next available Commission agenda. A deferment would allow OLS to attempt to settle this fairly large and complex matter with the Florida Public Service Commission in a timely and appropriate fashion.

For the following reasons, regulatory counsel submits the public interest would be served by the Commission granting its request.

1. Commission staff's preliminary talks with OLS on this matter were with a company representative, Mr. Canuel, who is not a lawyer and the Company had no legal representation during these dialogues.

2. Mr. Canuel was not authorized to represent OLS in any substantive negotiations with the Public Service Commission.

3. Management at OLS was not aware that Mr. Canuel was communicating with the PSC on substantive matters or that there was any

problem with the Company's compliance regime in Florida. In fact, the Company was only aware of approximately 50 complaints and was shocked to learn that staff was investigating over 200 complaints against OLS.

4. Given the Company's previously unblemished record in serving Florida consumers over the past four years, OLS should be granted additional time to thoroughly investigate the reasons behind the sudden recent surge in complaints. This is particularly true given that a cursory inspection of the complaints may support the premise that many of these complaints were trumped up by competitors and/or incumbent carriers.

4. Management retained the Helein Law Group as outside regulatory counsel to represent them in this matter at approximately 2:30 P.M. EST on March 27, 2001. At this time, management notified said regulatory counsel that a settlement proposal to avert a show cause was due by noon on March 29, 2001. This is insufficient time for counsel to prepare a reasonable and proper response, particularly given the large amounts of material and the charges involved.

5. In the interest of justice and fairness, Counsel respectfully requests copies of all complaints now pending against OLS and at least one week to review said complaints upon their receipt. This will allow counsel time to draft an adequate response to the Commission's charges.
