Dear Mr. Almeida:

The Commission received SC Communications' 2000 Regulatory Assessment Fee (RAF) Return with a note that the "business never started. Please discontinue notices.". There was no payment remitted with the RAF return.

Although SC Communications may have never started operations, Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code, provides that if a certificate is active for any day during a calendar year, the certificate holder owes the RAF for that year. Therefore, since SC Communications reported no revenues, the company owes \$53.00, which is the minimum fee (\$50.00), plus statutory penalty (\$2.50) and interest (\$0.50) charges.

If you respond by February 20, 2001 by paying the \$53.00, staff will make the effective date December 31, 2000 so that the 2001 fee will not be due. If, however, the \$53.00 is not received by that date, the effective date will be the date we receive the payment and the 2001 fee will be due. If you have any questions, just let me know.
