Pursuant to section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, BellSouth and International Web Technologies, Inc. now known as Metro FiberLink, Inc. are submitting to the Florida Public Service Commission an amendment to their negotiated agreement for the interconnection of their networks, the unbundling of specific network elements offered by BellSouth and the resale of BellSouth's telecommunications services to International Web Technologies, Inc. now known as Metro FiberLink, Inc. The Commission approved the initial agreement between the companies in Order No. 00-2069-FOF-TP issued October 30, 2000 in Docket 001106-TP. This amendment reflects the name change from International Web Technologies' to Metro FiberLink, Inc.

Pursuant to section 252(e) of the Act, the Commission is charged with approving or rejecting the negotiated agreement between BellSouth and International Web Technologies, Inc. now known as Metro FiberLink, Inc. within 90 days of its submission. The Act provides that the Commission may only reject such an agreement if it finds that the agreement or any portion of the agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or the implementation of the agreement or any portion of the agreement is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity. Both parties aver that neither of these reasons exist as to the agreement they have negotiated and therefore, are very hopeful that the Commission shall approve their agreement.
