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Tuesday, May 8, and Wednesday, May 9, 2001, have also been reserved for continuation of the hearing if needed. The starting time of the next day's session will be announced at the conclusion of the prior day. The hearing may be adjourned early if all testimony is concluded.

Customers will be given the opportunity to present testimony at the beginning of the morning session on Monday, May 7, 2001. Additionally, an evening session will be held beginning at 7:00 p.m., Monday, May 7, 2001, for the purpose of hearing testimony from customers who were unable to attend the prior session.

All customers wishing to testify are urged to be present at the beginning of the sessions, since the sessions may be adjourned early if no customers are present. By providing customer testimony, a person does not become a party to the proceeding. To become an official party of record, you must file a Petition for Intervention at least five days before the final hearing, pursuant to the requirements contained in Rule 25-22.039, Florida Administrative Code.

## PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE

The purpose of this hearing is to consider the applications of Nocatee Utility Corporation and Intercoastal Utilities, Inc. for certificates to operate a water and wastewater utility in Duval and St. Johns Counties and any motions or other matters that may be pending at the time of the hearing. The Commission may rule on any such motions from the bench or may take the matters under advisement.

At the hearing, all parties shall be given the opportunity to present testimony and other evidence on the issues identified by the parties at the prehearing conference held on April 16, 2001. All witnesses shall be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony.
