Please acknowledge receipt of this letter by stamping the extra copy of this letter "filed" and returning the same to me.



Dear Ms. Cater:

AT&T Wireless Services ("AWS") provides the following response to certain questions posed regarding our numbering resources in Florida, specifically in the 561, 904 and 954 area codes. AWS is providing this information to the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") as a courtesy.

Number Utilization Information: As we discussed during the conference call held on March 7, 2001, the Florida Commission through NANPA (North American Numbering Plan Administrator) already has access to the Numbering Resource Utilization/Forecast ("NRUF") reports that all carriers are required to file with the FCC and NANPA twice a year. This report provides the Commission with the majority of information requested including number utilization by the thousands block and the number of aging, reserved and available numbers by NXX. As you indicated on the conference call referenced above, the Commission already has access to the most recent NRUF filed on March 1, 2001. Therefore, it was agreed on the call that AWS did not need to provide additional copies of the NRUF or other information that is already contained in the NRUF report.

Copies of Code Request Forms and Part IVs: With respect to the request to review copies of code request forms submitted to NANPA from April 1, 2000 to March 15, 2001, AWS requested and received one code in the 561 area code during this timeframe. AWS will separately provide a copy of the part I code request form in a manner that protects the confidential information contained therein. AWS, also, returned eight codes to NANPA in 561, 904 and 954 during the period of time in question. If it would be beneficial to the Commission, AWS would be willing to send copies of the disconnect forms submitted to NANPA. In addition, copies of part IV forms submitted to NANPA since April 1, 2000 were requested. AWS is continuing to review its records and will provide the Commission with any additional relevant information at a later date.

Number Assignment Procedures: AWS, of course, has procedures in place to ensure that our number allocation process complies with all applicable FCC rules and INC guidelines. This process and relevant procedures are outlined in documents that are used for internal training purposes.

Reseller Information: You requested that AWS provide a list of "Names, Address, and Contact Name and Telephone Number of any entity in which you resell numbers to." AWS does not resell telephone numbers to any entity.

Number Pooling: Several of the questions request information that is only relevant to pooling carriers. Since AWS is a commercial mobile radio service provider, pursuant to FCC rules, we are not required to be local number portability capable until November 24, 2002 and therefore can not participate in pooling until that time.
