Dear Mr. Pribble:

On April 19, 2001, a docket was opened by staff of the Florida Public Service Commission for nonpayment of the 2000 Regulatory Assessment Fee (RAF), which was due January 30, 2001, plus statutory penalty and interest charges for the years 1998 and 2000. A late notice was mailed February 21, 2000. A review of our records show that to date, payment has not been received.

It is staff's intention to file a recommendation imposing a \$500 fine for this rule violation, or cancelling your telecommunications certificate. The Commissioners will vote at an upcoming Agenda Conference whether or not to accept staff's recommendation. A Proposed Agency Action Order will then be issued within 20 days after the vote and your company will have 21 days to protest the Order. It should be noted that just paying the delinquent 1999 penalty and interest amount will not prevent your certificate from being cancelled.

If the Order is not protested and the past due amount is not paid, then your certificate will be cancelled, and the past due amount will be turned over to the Florida Comptroller's Office for further collection attempts. Therefore, it is important that you contact staff as soon as possible, but no later than May 23, 2001, to find out what your options are.
