

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF COMPLAINT

Forest Lake Estates Co-op, Inc. ("the Co-op"), hereby files
Notice of Withdrawal of Complaint, and states:

1. The withdrawal of the complaint is based upon the
assurances of Labrador Services, Inc. ("the Utility"), as stated
in the letter of March 30, 2001, from the Utility's attorney,
Richard S. Webb, to Patti Daniel, Chief, Bureau of
Certification, that the Utility intends to commit its financial
resources, as needed, to maintain the Utility and comply with
applicable laws. The Co-op also understands that the PSC will
conduct a thorough analysis of the Utility's financial ability
as part of this docket.

2. Further, the Answer to the Complaint indicates that
Labrador Services, Inc., has been responsive to the allegations
of the residents regarding past odor problems, by engaging an

engineering consultant to inspect the plant and by meeting with FDEP.

3. Finally, the Co-op is not currently experiencing significant odor problems, which it hopes is attributable to a more stable state of affairs now that Ms. Sylvie Viau has been appointed administrator of the Viau estate.

4. The Co-op will remain an Interested Person in this docket, through its undersigned attorneys.
