Financial Qualifications

In support of its financial qualifications, Applicant submits its unaudited financial statements for the years 1998, 1999 and 2000 (see attached). Applicant has been providing wholesale international interexchange and domestic interstate interexchange services, pursuant to FCC authority, since it was certified on January 22, 1999. See File No. ITC-214-19981203-00849. Applicant seeks to expand its operations to include wholesale local exchange access services. Applicant intends to provide such services through its own facilities (i.e., switches) the lease and/or purchase of unbundled network elements ("UNEs"). Applicant notes that simultaneously with this application, Applicant has filed an application seeking authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services.

As indicated in Attachment B, Applicant presently owns four switches. Accordingly, Applicant will not need to make significant capital expenditures to expand its operations. Further, Applicant has additional financial resources available to it. Specifically, Applicant has a \$50,000 credit line with Washington Mutual Bank. For these reasons, Applicant is financially capable to provide and maintain ALEC services in the State of Florida, and to meet its lease and ownership obligations.

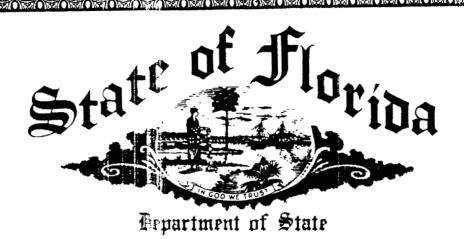

The undersigned incorporator hereby forms a corporation under Chapter 607 of the laws of the State of Florida.
