Dear Ms. Rafeek:

This is a follow up to our May 25 telephone conversation concerning the above docket. I believe in our conversation, you stated you wished to keep your pay telephone certificate active. If this is the case, you will probably want to propose a settlement, which means that you should write the Commission a letter that includes the following elements:

- 1) Docket number;
- 2) A check for the past due amount in full (breakdown enclosed). It should be noted that just paying the past due amount will not prevent your certificate from being cancelled;
- 3) A statement that the company has taken steps to prevent future late payments of the regulatory assessment fees and what those steps are;
- 4) A waiver of objection, which should state: The company agrees to waive any objection to the administrative cancellation of its certificate should it fail to pay in accordance with its settlement offer. If, however, there is a factual dispute as to the manner or level of compliance with any provision in the settlement, Commission staff will bring the matter to the Commission for consideration; and
- 5) Make a specific monetary settlement.
