

3. The Commission granted Time Warner a certificate of authority in Docket No. 95-0906 to provide services as an Alternative Local Exchange Company in Florida. Time Warner is a facilities-based carrier that provides exchange access and local exchange telecommunications services in Florida. Accordingly, Time Warner is subject to the rules, regulations, and orders of the Commission, and such rules, regulations, and orders impact Time Warner in the provision of telecommunications services in Florida, and Time Warner's ability to compete in areas in which BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., is the Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier.

4. The Commission's decision in this generic docket will have precedential impact on future decisions of the Commission and, in turn, upon Time Warner. Thus, the interests of Time Warner Telecom may or will be substantially affected by any decision regarding establishment of an expedited process for reviewing NANPA denials of applications for use of additional NXX future denials of applications for use of additional NXX codes.

For the reasons stated above, Time Warner respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Petition for Leave to Intervene and accord Time Warner full party status in this proceeding.


