Within 20 days of the Commission's decision at the Agenda Conference, the utility should provide notice of the Commission's decision to all customers in the service area who are affected by the tariff revisions. The notice should be approved by Commission staff prior to distribution. The utility should provide proof that the appropriate customers have received notice within ten days of the date of the notice. The tariffs should become effective on or after the stamped approval date on the tariff sheets, pursuant to Rule 25-30.475, Florida Administrative Code.
