

**NOTICE IN SUPPORT OF FPL AND TECO COMMENTS AND SUGGESTIONS
REGARDING THE IDENTIFICATION OF ISSUES**

Enron Corporation ("Enron") filed with this Commission on July 9, 2001, a motion to intervene on a limited basis in each of the three dockets referenced above. Enron has a substantial and immediate interest in the outcome of this proceeding as it relates to the prudence of forming a RTO. Although this Commission has not yet issued an order regarding Enron's status as an intervenor, Enron is participating in framing the issues this Commission will decide in Phase I of the above-referenced dockets.

Enron hereby files the following Notice in Support of the Comments and Suggestions Regarding the Identification of Issues filed on behalf of Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") and Tampa Electric Company ("TECO"):

1. Enron supports the issues as framed by FPL and TECO. Enron believes the five issues as formulated by TECO and FPL are succinct statements of the basic


issues this Commission will consider and, as such, they will serve as useful guideposts for the hearing.

2. Enron believes the issues identified by all interested parties and persons are subsumed within the five primary issues presented on behalf of FPL and TECO.

Enron notes and agrees with the position of Florida Power Corporation that the Commission will necessarily address the issues raised by other interested persons and parties, including PSC Staff and the Office of Public Counsel, in the course of its consideration of the five primary issues as formulated by FPL and TECO. Indeed, the "issues" that others identify appear to state their respective positions on the five primary issues, rather than stating additional primary issues that the Commission should consider in this expedited proceeding.

WHEREFORE, Enron Corporation respectfully requests that the Prehearing Officer of the Florida Public Service Commission enter an order establishing the issues for Phase I as set forth by FPL and TECO.


