

ACCESS INTEGRATED NETWORKS, INC.'S PETITION TO INTERVENE

3. Statement of Substantial Interests:

ACCESS Integrated Networks, Inc. ("ACCESS"), is an Alternative Local Exchange Company ("ALEC") that operates in the states in which BellSouth serves as the Incumbent Local

Exchange Company ("ILEC"), including Florida. Pursuant to the provisions of the 1996 Telecommunications Act and the terms of its interconnection agreements with BellSouth, ACCESS purchases from BellSouth certain unbundled network elements which ACCESS uses to serve its local exchange customers. As part of its overall package of services, ACCESS also provides long distance service to its customers. In this proceeding, the Commission will consider whether to support or oppose BellSouth's application to the FCC for authority to participate in the interLATA long distance market. A decision to allow BellSouth to enter the interLATA market prior to the time it has fully opened its network to competition in the local exchange market would provide BellSouth with an unfair competitive advantage against ACCESS, thereby affecting ACCESS' substantial interests.

4. Statement of Disputed Issues of Material Fact:

ACCESS adopts the issues identified in Order No. PSC-01-1025-PCO-TL, dated April 25, 2001.

5. Ultimate Facts Alleged:

Because BellSouth engages in anti-competitive activities designed to undermine the development of competition in the local exchange market, it has failed to provide nondiscriminatory interconnection and access of a quality equal to that which BellSouth provides to itself in violation of the 1996 Act; for the same reason, BellSouth has failed to provide access to network elements on terms that are just reasonable, and non-discriminatory, as required by the 1996 Act.

WHEREFORE, ACCESS Integrated Networks, Inc. requests the Commission to enter an order authorizing it to intervene in this docket as a full party.
