

Dear Number-Pooling-Capable Company:

On July 31, 2001, the Florida Public Service Commission (FPSC) issued Order No. PSC-01-1577-FOF-TP in the above-referenced docket finding that a number pooling trial shall be implemented in the Tampa Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) on October 1, 2001. The trial is to include all uncontaminated thousands blocks of NXX codes and all other blocks with less than 10% contamination. Under the Order, all non-wireless local number portability (LNP)-capable carriers are to participate in the pooling trial.

At the FPSC's request, an industry conference call was conducted on August 7, 2001 to begin planning for the implementation of the number pooling trial. During the call, the FPSC Staff clarified that the pooling trial was intended to be voluntary. There was consensus that the trial will have minimal number conservation benefits unless it has wide industry participation. Verizon, as the company that initially offered to do the voluntary pooling trial, committed to contacting the number-pooling-capable industry participants to confirm their intention to participate. Your signature below will indicate that your company plans to participate in the voluntary 813 NPA number pooling trial.

Please fax the executed letter to the attention of Terry Scobie at 813-204-8870 by **August 15** so we can compile all responses and share the data with the Commission Staff before the next scheduled industry meeting on Monday, August 20, 2001.
