FLORIDA WATER SERVICES CORPORATION'S AMENDMENT TO AMENDED PREHEARING STATEMENT

Florida Water Services Corporation ("Florida Water"), by and through its undersigned counsel, hereby files this Amendment to Florida Water's Amended Prehearing Statement filed on August 31, 2001, for the purpose of providing Florida Water's position on Issue 2.

<u>Issue No. 2</u>: If any portion of the gain on sale is allocated to the ratepayers, what is the appropriate regulatory treatment of that allocation?

Florida Water: Based on prior Commission precedent, there is no "appropriate" regulatory treatment for the allocation of any portion of the gain on sale of Florida Water's Orange County systems. Prior Commission decisions confirm that the Commission has consistently determined that the shareholders of the utility whose capital finance the utility properties, business and stream of revenues should bear the risk of loss or derive the benefit of the gain on the sale of a water or wastewater system. If the Commission were to unlawfully depart from that precedent, any portion of the gain on sale allocated to ratepayers should be amortized from the date of sale.
