
IDS Telecom, L.L.C. (hereinafter "IDS"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, files this its Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification.

- 1. On September 6, 2001, IDS filed its Notice of Service of Second Supplemental Responses to BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc.'s Interrogatories Nos. 1 103 and hand delivered a copy of the IDS' Second Supplemental Responses to BellSouth's Interrogatories Nos. 1 103 to BellSouth's Miami Office. The confidential information contained within some of these Responses is protected by a Protective Agreement entered into by IDS and BellSouth on August 23, 2001.
- On September 6, 2001, IDS hand delivered a redacted copy of IDS'
   Second Supplemental Responses to BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc.'s
   Interrogatories Nos. 1 103 to the Commission Staff Counsel and to the Office of Public Counsel.

This notice of intent was filed in a docketed matter by or on behalf of a "telco" for Confidential DN 1195-0 . The confidential material is in locked storage pending staff advice on handling.

- 3. On September 6, 2001, IDS filed its Second Supplemental Responses to BellSouth's Interrogatories Nos. 50, 59, 83, 92, 101, and 103 with the Division of Records and Reporting.
- 4. The information contained in the Second Supplemental Responses to BellSouth's Interrogatories Nos. 50, 59, 83, 92, 101, and 103 contain certain of IDS' customers' account information, including names, addresses, telephone numbers, and account information that is required to be maintained as confidential by Section 364.24, Florida Statutes.
- 5. On September 6, 2001, IDS filed a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification for the confidential information contained in its Second Supplemental Responses to BellSouth's Interrogatories Nos. 50, 59, 83, 92, 101, and 103. In the Notice filed September 6, 2001, IDS inadvertently left out the document provided in its Second Supplemental Response to Interrogatory No. 5, which contains confidential information, and the Second Supplemental Responses to Interrogatories Nos. 8, 35, 49, and 59 which contain confidential information.
- 6. Because this information is required to be maintained as confidential by IDS, IDS is now filing this Revised Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, in order to allow the Commission to take possession of IDS' Supplemental Responses without delay.
- 7. The original of this notice has been filed with the Division of Records and Reporting, and a copy has been served on all parties of record.
