AMENDATORY ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 11, 2001, we issued Order No. PSC-01-1830-PCO-TL regarding testimony to be stricken in this proceeding. Due to a scrivener's error, however, Attachment D incorrectly reflected that the testimony of NuVox witness Willis was to be stricken, and failed to include that the testimony of Access Integrated witness Page is stricken. Therefore, the Order is amended to delete the reference to NuVox witness Willis, and to include the following in Attachment D to the Order:

page 3, line 1 through page 9, line 21 and page 13, line 10 through page 19, line 6. However, witness Campbell's testimony ends at page 9, line 8. Therefore, Attachment A is amended to reflect the following:

Finally, the Order at page 7 is clarified to reflect that Florida Digital Network did not move to strike the testimony of witness Page, but instead asserted that if witness Page's testimony was to be stricken, then the testimony of witness Cox and Exhibit CKC-10 should also be stricken.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Attachment D to Order No. PSC-01-1830-PCO-TL is hereby amended to reflect that the testimony of witness Willis is not stricken. It is further

ORDERED that Attachment D to Order No. PSC-01-1830-PCO-TL is hereby amended to reflect that the testimony of witness Page is stricken. It is further

ORDERED that Attachment D to Order No. PSC-01-1830-PCO-TL is hereby amended to reflect the correction regarding the testimony of witness Davis that is to be stricken as identified in the body of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that Attachment A is hereby amended to reflect the correction regarding the testimony of witness Campbell that is to be stricken as identified in the body of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that the clarification identified in the body of this Order with regard to Florida Digital Network, Inc.'s assertions is made to Order No. PSC-01-1830-PCO-TL.

ORDERED that Order No. PSC-01-1830-PCO-TL is reaffirmed in all other respects.
