**PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF  
FLORIDA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMPANY'S  
PURCHASED GAS COST RECOVERY FACTOR**

Florida Public Utilities Company ("the Company"), through its undersigned attorneys and pursuant to the requirements of this docket, hereby petitions the Commission for approval of the Company's purchased gas cost recovery factors for the period January, 2002 through December, 2002. In support hereof, the Company states:

1) The Company is a natural gas utility company within the jurisdiction of this Commission. Its principal business address is:

3) Pursuant to the requirements of this Docket, the Company has prefiled the purchased gas cost recovery forms supplied by the Electric & Gas Department in a manner consistent with the Department's instructions.

4) As indicated in the prefiled forms, the Company experienced an underrecovery of \$1,395,028 for the period January, 2000 through December, 2000 and estimates an overrecovery of

\$1,761,048 for the period January, 2001 through December, 2001, for a total overrecovery of \$366,020. Based upon estimated sales of 45,181,270, it will be necessary to subtract 0.810 cents per therm to refund this overrecovery.

5) The Company has also projected its purchased gas costs for the period January, 2001 through December, 2001. As indicated in the accompanying schedules, the maximum purchased gas cost recovery factor is 83.412 cents per therm. This rate includes projected cost of gas purchased, prior period true-up, and revenue tax factors, and is based upon projected sales.

WHEREFORE, Florida Public Utilities Company petitions the Commission to approve the foregoing purchased gas cost recovery factors, to be applied to customer bills for the period January, 2002 through December, 2002, and to billings thereafter until other purchased gas cost recovery factors are approved by the Commission.
