PLEASE READ THE PROOF OF CLAIM FORM CAREFULLY AND FILL IT IN COMPLETELY AND ACCURATELY. PRINT LEGIBLY. YOUR CLAIM MAY BE DISALLOWED IF IT CANNOT BE READ AND UNDERSTOOD. - DEFINITIONS -

Debtor

The person, corporation or other entity that has filed a bankruptcy case is called the debtor.

Creditor

A creditor is any person, corporation or other entity to whom the debtor owed a debt on the date that the bankruptcy case was filed.

Proof of Claim

A form identifying the amount a creditor believes was owed to it by the debtor at the time the bankruptcy case was filed (i.e., the amount of the creditor's claim).

Secured Claim

A claim is a secured claim to the extent that the creditor has a lien on property of the debtor (<u>i.e.</u>, collateral) that gives the creditor the right to be paid from that property before creditors who do not have liens on the property.

Examples of liens are mortgages on real estate and security interests in cars, trucks, boats, television sets or other items of property. A lien may have been obtained through a court proceeding before the bankruptcy case began; in some states a court judgment is a lien. In addition, to the extent a creditor also owes money to the debtor (<u>i.e.</u>, has a right of setoff), the creditor's claim may be a secured claim. (See also *Unsecured Claim*.)

Unsecured Claim

If a claim is not a secured claim, it is an unsecured claim. A claim may be partly secured and partly unsecured if the property on which a creditor has a lien does not have sufficient value to satisfy the creditor in full.

Unsecured Priority Claim

Certain types of unsecured claims are given priority under the Bankruptcy Code and are paid in bankruptcy cases before most other unsecured claims (if there is sufficient money or property available to pay these claims). The most common types of priority claims are listed on the proof of claim form. Unsecured claims that are not specifically given priority status by the bankruptcy laws are classified as Unsecured Nonpriority Claims.

Information about Creditor:

A claim may be partly a priority claim and partly a nonpriority claim if, for example, the claim is in an amount exceeding the amount given priority by the law. Check the appropriate place to specify the type of priority claim.

7. Credits

By signing this proof of claim, you are stating under oath that, in calculating the amount of your claim, you have given the debtor credit for all payments received from the debtor.

8. Supporting Documents:

You must attach to this proof of claim form copies of documents that show the debtor owes the debt claimed or that any asserted security interests have been perfected. If these documents are too lengthy, a summary of such documents must be provided. If documents are not available, you must attach a statement explaining why they are not available.

- Schedules of creditors have been filed pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 1007. Any creditor holding a scheduled claim which is not listed as disputed, contingent, or unliquidated as to amount may, but is not required to, file a proof of claim in these cases. Creditors whose claims are not scheduled or whose claims are listed as disputed, contingent, or unliquidated as to amount and who desire to participate in the cases or share in any distribution must file their proofs of claim. A creditor who desires to rely on the schedules of creditors has the responsibility of determining that its claim is listed accurately. Holders of the Debtors' equity securities (whether preferred or common stock) are not required to file a proof of interest solely on account of such holders' ownership interest in or possession of such equity securities.
- 2. You should not file a proof of claim if you do not have a claim against any of the Debtors or if your claim has been previously allowed or paid by order of the Court. Any other claims arising before the Petition Date respecting any leases or contracts of the Debtors must be filed by the Bar Date.
- 7. If you are required to submit a proof of claim to preserve your claim against any of the Debtors and the Claims Agent does not actually receive your original proof of claim in the manner described above on or before the Bar Date or other applicable deadline, you shall be forever barred from asserting any such claim against any of the Debtors or their successors or assigns, and you will be barred from receiving any distribution made during these chapter 11 cases by the Debtors or their creditors.
