1. In an e-mail dated October 4, 2001, the Florida Public Service Commission Staff ("Staff"), requested that BellSouth provide information on PIC histories for both local toll and toll providers from November 1, 2000 to October 4, 2001. Today, BellSouth is providing the requested information to Staff.

2. BellSouth is filing this Request for Confidential Classification because the information contained in its response constitutes confidential business and customer specific information, and therefore, is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes.
