This letter is in response to the above-referenced docket and intended to be a Settlement Proposal as required by said docket.

Please note that the company was transferred to a new parent company as stated in the filings in Docket No. 010662-TI, in August 2001. During this sale, it was discovered that the company had not met its regulatory obligations in the State of Florida. We arranged for and the company did pay its past due Regulatory Fees in July 2001. Mistakenly, we assumed that this was all that was required to return the company to regulatory compliance. As part of the transfer, Telecom Professionals, Inc. was retained to make all required regulatory filings in the future. The company believes that this step will help prevent future delinquent filings.

The company would like to offer a settlement in the amount of \$100.00 for the failure to timely file and pay the Regulatory Assessments. We would appreciate your consideration of this offer.

The company agrees to waive any objection to the administrative cancellation of its certificate should it fail to pay in accordance with this settlement offer. If, however, there is a factual dispute as to the manner or level of compliance with any provision in the settlement, Commission staff will bring the matter to the Commission for consideration.
