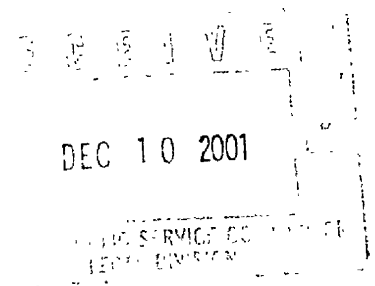


1. Meter reading;
