#### PETITION FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF AN AFUDC RATE

PETITIONER, Forest Utilities, Inc. (hereinafter "Petitioner", "Utility" or "Forest"), pursuant to Chapter 367, Florida Statutes, and Section 25-30.116, Florida Administrative Code, hereby files this Petition for Establishment of an Allowance for Funds Used During Construction (AFUDC) Rate and in support thereof states as follows:

I.

The following information is provided in accordance with the requirements of Rule 25-22.036(7), FAC:

(a) The name and address of the Petitioner is:

(b) Petitioner's interest:
