The organization must register for sales and use tax certification, and collect and remit sales tax on those transactions. Note: Churches are exempt from this requirement except when they are the lessor of real property (Section 12A-1.070, Florida Administrative Code).
- Changes in the organization's purpose, federal exemption status, or address must be reported immediately to the Department of Revenue.
