On September 1, 2000, Tampa Electric Company (TECO) filed pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, a request for confidential classification of portions of the proposed special contract with IMC Phosphates Company (IMC), Document No. 10828-00.

Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, defines "proprietary confidential business information" as:

[I]nformation, regardless of form or characteristics, which is owned or controlled by the person or company, is intended to be and is treated by the person or company as private in that the disclosure of the information would cause harm to the ratepayers or the person's or company's business operations, and has not been disclosed unless disclosed pursuant to a statutory provision, an order of a court or administrative body, or private agreement that provides that the information will not be released to the public.

TECO asserts that the contract contains negotiated rates, terms or conditions, and details regarding IMC's self generating capacity. TECO maintains that IMC has indicated that the above referenced information is proprietary information which IMC does not wish to share with its competitors. TECO states that both TECO and IMC treat the information as confidential and have not disclosed it to other parties.

Staff has reviewed the document and finds that all the lines TECO identified, meet the confidentiality criteria of Section 366.093, Florida Statutes. This information contains specific negotiated contract information. Public disclosure of this information would harm IMC and TECO's ability to negotiate future contracts.
