Gulf Power Company ["Gulf Power", "Gulf", or "the Company"], by and through its undersigned attorney's and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby gives notice that it intends to request confidential classification for portions of Gulf Powers's response to Staff's Fifth Request for Production of Documents to Gulf Power Company (Nos. 39-49). A copy of the requests is attached hereto as exhibit "A".
- 3. Gulf Power Company's response to requests numbered 42 44 contain proprietary and commercially sensitive information which, if disclosed publically, would cause irreparable harm to the business interests of Gulf power Company. Gulf asserts that this information meets the requirements of §366.093(3)(a) and (e), Florida Statutes. A formal request for confidential classification will be filed within the time period specified in Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, if the Staff determines that the information will be

retained by the Commission and not returned to Gulf Power Company within the specified time period. In the event the Staff determines that it will retain this information, Gulf Power Company requests to be notified, through the undersigned counsel, prior to the expiration of the period specified in Rule 25-22.006(3)(a).
