P. Furthermore, The Woodlands of Lake Placid, L.P. shall not look to Highlands Utilities Corporation for any remuneration whatsoever related to the costs of deleting the area from Highlands Utilities Corporation and including the area in The Woodlands of Lake Placid, L. P.
