

2. Gulf Power Company ["Gulf Power", "Gulf", or "the Company"], by and through its undersigned attorney's and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby gives notice that it intends to request confidential classification for portions of Gulf Powers's response to Staff's Ninth Request for Production of Documents to Gulf Power Company (Nos. 61-64). A copy of the requests is attached hereto as exhibit "A".

3. Gulf Power Company's response to request numbered 64 contains proprietary and commercially sensitive information regarding Gulf and certain of its customers which if disclosed to the general public would cause irreparable harm to the Company or those customers. This information has been granted confidential classification by the Florida Public Service Commission in Order No. PSC-01-2254-CFO-EI in Docket No. 010949-EI. The document being provided in this instance is electronic in form and is the same information

previously provided in non-electronic format. Gulf asserts that this information meets the requirements of §366.093(3)(a) and (e), Florida Statutes. A formal request for confidential classification will be filed within the time period specified in Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, if the Staff determines that the information will be retained by the Commission and not returned to Gulf Power Company within the specified time period. In the event the Staff determines that it will retain this information, Gulf Power Company requests to be notified, through the undersigned counsel, prior to the expiration of the period specified in Rule 25-22.006(3)(a).
