The purpose of this hearing is to permit parties to present testimony and exhibits relative to the review of the retail rates of Florida Power & Light Company and to address any motions or other matters that may be pending at the time of the hearing. The Commission may rule on any such motions from the bench or may take the matters under advisement.

At the hearing, all parties shall be given the opportunity to present testimony and other evidence on the issues identified by the parties at the prehearing conference held on March 25, 2002. All witnesses shall be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony.


Jurisdiction
