Dear :

This letter is to advise you of our plans to discontinue our "re-sale" local exchange, toll and switched access and related services in your State by March 14, 2002 pursuant to Section 214(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the "Act"), 47 U.S.C. section 63.71 of the Commissions Rules to discontinue the provision of all "resold" U.S. Domestic telecommunications services in your respective state.

By way of background, ARBROS is a competitive local exchange carrier providing a variety of local and interstate services including local, long distance, PRI, ISDN, internet access, and voice mail both through the resale of services and ARBROS "on-net" services. ARBROS has made a necessary business decision to focus its resources only in the States of New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Maryland, Virginia, Delaware, and the District of Columbia, and only for its "on-net" services, therefore necessitating the discontinuance of its resale services.

NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

ARBROS has sent letters to affected customers notifying them of the planned discontinuance. The letters have been distributed to all affected ARBROS customers between January 12, and January 14, 2002.
