RE: GTC, Inc. d/b/a GT Com - Tariff Filing to Increase Rates for Basic Services Pursuant to Section 364.051, Florida Statutes

On February 22, 2002, pursuant to Section 364.051(3), Florida Statutes, GTC, Inc. d/b/a GT Com (GTC) filed a tariff to increase rates effective April 1, 2002, for its flat rate residential and single line business local exchange services. In addition, the company filed to increase rates for rotary services and PBX Trunks.

GTC is increasing its rates by 1.50 percent. Depending on the customer's service area, the monthly rates will increase as follows:

- 1. flat rate residential services \$.09-\$.13;
- 2. single line business services \$.23-\$.36;
- rotary services \$.33-\$.46;
- 4. PBX trunks (two-ways) \$.49-\$.99;
- 5. PBX trunks (inward only) \$.37-\$.39

Staff has reviewed the filing, and the rate increases for basic services are within the prescribed limits allowed pursuant to Section 364.051(3), Florida Statutes. The rate increases will be administratively acknowledged, effective April 1, 2002, pursuant to Section 2.07(C) of the Commission's Administrative Procedures Manual.
