**RE:** Undocketed - Generator Interconnection Procedures and Agreements

Subsequent to the Notice of Commission Workshop, issued with respect to the above-referenced matter on April 5, 2002, Commission staff identified additional issues for discussion at the workshop. These issues are as follows:

- 1. What is the tax effect of a transaction where an independent generator contributes or pays for transmission system upgrades to the IOU?
- 2. Should the tax effect of the contribution, if any, be collected from the independent generator through gross up?
- 3. If gross up is collected, how does this affect project feasibility and the level of competition in the wholesale generation market?
- 4. How does IRS Notice 2001-82, issued December 6, 2001, regarding intertie lines, relate to this issue?
