TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S PRELIMINARY LIST OF ISSUES

Pursuant to the procedural schedule set forth in Order No. PSC-02-0442-PCO-EU, Order Establishing Procedure, issued on April 2, 2002, Tampa Electric Company hereby submits the following Preliminary List of Issues.

- 1. Pursuant to the standard set forth in Order No. 23995, issued in Docket No. 900744-EU on January 3, 1991, has the City of Bartow sufficiently established the existence of changed conditions or changed circumstances not present at the time of the Commission's original consideration of the Bartow/Tampa Electric Service Territory Agreement in Docket No. 850148-EU that make modification of the existing service territory agreement necessary in the public interest?
- 2. Does the annexation by a municipal electric utility of territory currently served by another electric utility pursuant to an order of the Florida Public Service Commission entitle the annexing municipality, as a matter of law, to take over the provision of electric service in the newly annexed territory?
- 3. Has Tampa Electric constructed transmission and distribution facilities in anticipation of its obligation to serve the Old Florida Plantation ("OFP") property pursuant to FPSC Decision No. 15473, issued in Docket No. 850148-EU on December 11, 1985?
- 4. What is the proximity to the OFP property of the electric distribution facilities currently operated by Tampa Electric and the City of Bartow that would be used to provide electric service to the OFP property and what is the currently available capacity on such facilities?
- 5. Aside from the distribution facilities that would have to be constructed within the OFP property, what transmission and/or distribution additions or upgrades would be required by the City of Bartow or Tampa Electric to serve: a) their respective portions of the OFP property under the existing service territory agreement and b) the entire OFP development at full build out?
- 6. Is there a natural boundary or other geographical feature on the OFP property that suggests an alternative to the existing service territory boundary between Tampa Electric and the City of Bartow that would promote more efficient and reliable service to the future residents of the OFP property?
