
I am writing this letter to inform you of BellSouth's response to the issues raised in AT&T's April 15, 2002 letter, wherein AT&T raises two questions.

First, AT&T questions whether BellSouth has implemented the 930 routing method in LATAs where BellSouth does not have any Uniserve customers. The answer to this question is that, at this time, BellSouth has not and does not intend to implement the proposed routing method in LATAs in which BellSouth does not have any Uniserve customers. Although Uniserve is a BellSouth tariff offering, BellSouth is currently in the process of eliminating the service, and as pointed out in my letter dated March 12, 2002, BellSouth expects to return the 930 codes by March 2003. In addition, BellSouth is not actively marketing the service to new customers. If for some reason prior to the time the service is totally obsoleted and the codes returned, BellSouth implements Uniserve service in a LATA that currently does not have the 930 routing method, BellSouth will implement the routing method in that additional LATA.

AT&T's second question centers on whether BellSouth will implement a routing method that will enable calls to 780 to complete. BellSouth has allowed ALEC to route their customers 780 traffic over their local interconnection trunks since October 1996. BellSouth has requested that AT&T provide specifics network information so as to determine the reason for the routing problem. In an attempt to resolve AT&T's routing problem, BellSouth would recommend some joint testing to determine the specific reason for the inability to route 780 traffic over AT&T local interconnection trunks.
