PURPOSE

The purpose of this workshop is to provide all parties of record the opportunity to address issues with respect to the modified GridFlorida Regional Transmission Organization proposal filed March 20 and 21, 2002, in this docket. As set forth in the Commission staff's April 12, 2002, memorandum to all parties, parties should focus their comments on the following subjects: (1) appropriateness of a not-for-profit versus for-profit ISO; (2) flexibility of the RTO plan and documents to change over time; (3) applicability of Code of Conduct to GridFlorida, the Board of Directors, the Board Selection Committee, and the Stakeholder Advisory Committee; (4) meetings open to the public; (5)

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performance incentives and the mechanism to implement incentives; (6) role of the Florida Public Service Commission; (7) consideration of demand side options and generation alternatives when identifying needed expansion and maintaining reliability; (8) available transmission capacity (ATC) and the role of participating owners in determining ATC; (9) use of physical transmission rights; (10) method for determining flowgates; (11) pricing of ancillary services; (12) proposed cost recovery mechanism; (13) inclusion of transmission dependent utility (TDU) costs in zonal rates; and (14) revenue shifts resulting from the de-pancaking of rates.

The GridFlorida Companies collectively will be allotted 30 minutes to present the modified GridFlorida RTO proposal. Each party that filed pre-workshop comments shall be allotted 30 minutes for presentation of its comments. In planning presentations, parties should be mindful that only one day is allotted for this workshop. Thus, to the extent possible, parties are asked to coordinate their presentations to minimize redundancy and utilize the allotted time most efficiently.
