<u>ISSUE 1</u>: Should the Commission schedule a rule development workshop to discuss the potential revisions to Rule 25-22.082, Florida Administrative Code, contained in Attachment A of staff's May 9, 2002 recommendation? <u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: Yes. The Request For Proposals (RFP) process is a tool to be used to justify a capacity selection. The proposed revisions are an attempt to utilize this tool more effectively based upon experience gained over the past several years. Specifically, the revisions would: (1) require investor-owned utilities to issue RFPs for major (greater than 150 MW) capacity additions; (2) allow participants to submit, and require investor-owned utilities to evaluate, proposals for generating facilities that would be collocated on the utility's existing site; (3) maintain existing regulatory processes for cost recovery approval; and (4) allow bilateral contracts with terms less than three years to be exempt from the RFP process.
