Enclosed are an original and four copies of this letter, together with an original and four copies of the revised tariff sheets referenced below, for filing in this docket.

This docket involves a territory amendment application filed by Florida Water Services Corporation ("Florida Water"). The original application included several parcels proposed to be added to Florida Water's existing service territory in Lake County. Since the filing of the application, it has been determined that certain portions of the requested new territory do not have a current need for service. Accordingly, Florida Water submits the enclosed revised tariff sheets which include only those portions of the originally requested territory for which there is a current need for service. In other words, the legal description from the original application is being amended to delete those areas where there is not a current need for service. A map depicting the areas set forth on these revised tariff sheets is being provided to Richard Redemann of the Commission Staff.

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Crystal River Utilities, Inc. ("Crystal River") filed an objection in this docket opposing the original territory amendment application. Undersigned counsel for Florida Water has been in contact with counsel for Crystal River and the parties have reached a settlement that will result in the dismissal of that objection. That settlement is currently being reduced to writing following which Crystal River will file a dismissal of its objections in this docket. In view of these developments,

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Florida Water suggests that a revised CASR be issued to allow for consideration of the territory application as amended, including rescheduling the prehearing conference currently scheduled for June 17, 2002.
