Gentlemen;

I am enclosing a copy of page 1 of the Legal Notice we received recently from Florida Water Services Corp. stating in part their application for an original certificate of authorization for an existing utility currently charging for service. It is my understanding, that in effect it is an attempt to take control of the water system away from our Board of County Commissioners. Common sense says they wish to increase our rates for water and sewer services by being under control of the FPSC.

From past experience, and with all due respect, with the recent rate increases to home and automobile insurance policies, a request for a rate increase will be approved without regard to the public's outcry.

I respectfully request their application be disallowed not only because of the ambiguous notice we received but because I believe a rate increase is not warranted. The present rates were set by our Commission after it was determined their past rates were excessive and new rates were lowered to "even the score of over-charges".

In addition, I have recently requested a change in the sewage charge by Florida Water. We are charged sewage fees for a standard of 6,000 gallons per month whereas I have county records that can prove I have never used 6,000 gallons of potable water for personal use. I believe the charge should be decreased to 4,000 gallons. I realize this is not on your agenda at the present but should the water company be regulated by your agency, I hope you will give this point some consideration.

Again, I ask that you turn down any and all requests by the said water corporation that will affect the residents of Hernando and Pasco Counties.
