

Staff requests permission to withdraw its recommendation for Docket No. 020562-EI, which the Commission will take up as Item No. 16 at the July 23, 2002, Agenda Conference.

The recommendation addresses FPL's request for approval of a tariff to allow streetlight monitoring devices to be billed on the Street Lighting (SL-1) rate schedule. The proposal was prompted by a request from the City of Stuart, who wants to install 40 of the devices on FPL-owned lights located in Stuart. In its request, FPL told staff that the City would pay FPL the full cost of installing the devices on the streetlights. On the basis of that representation, staff recommended in its memorandum filed on July 11, 2002, that the proposed tariff revision be approved.

Subsequent to the filing of the recommendation, on the morning of Monday, July 22, 2002, FPL contacted staff and indicated that the arrangement with the City of Stuart had been modified, and that now the City would not be liable for the installation costs. Due to this change, FPL is withdrawing its petition.
