WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, has determined that Resolution 2001-128 shall be rescinded.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 15th day of July, 2002, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:
