

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2.8 Restoration of Service

The use and restoration of service shall be in accordance with the priority system specified in part 64, Subpart D of the FCC Rules and Regulations.

2.9 Deposit

No deposits are required from customers or subscribers.

2.10 Advance Payments

IDT reserves the right to collect an advance payment from customers in an amount not to exceed one (1) month's estimated charges as an advance payment for service. This will be applied against the next month's charges, and if necessary, a new advance payment will be collected for the next month.

2.11 Taxes

All federal, state and local taxes, assessments, surcharges, or fees, including sales taxes, use taxes, gross receipts taxes, and municipal utilities taxes are billed as separate line items and are not included in the rates quoted herein, except as described for Prepaid Calling Cards and Rechargeable Calling Cards. A flat tax rate of 20% will be applied to all charges associated with the DSA Telecom Calling Card.

2.12 Late Charge

A late fee of 1.5% monthly will be charged on any past due balances.

2.13 Returned Check Charge

A fee of \$25.00 will be charged whenever a check or draft presented for payment for service is not accepted by the institution on which it is written.

2.14 Reconnection Charge

A reconnection fee of \$5.00 per line per occurrence will be charged when service is re-established for customers which have been disconnected due to non-payment.

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SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

3 1 Computation of Charges

3.1.1 The total charge for each completed call may be a variable measured charge dependent on the duration, distance and time of day of the call. The total charge for each completed call may also be a variable measured charge dependent on the duration and time of day of the call, i.e., a statewide flat rate per minute charge. 1+ Dialing and 8XX Service calls are measured in six-second increments. Prepaid Local Access Number Cards, 800 Debit Cards, Rechargeable Calling Cards and Travel Cards are measured in one (1) minute increments with a one-minute minimum per call. Operator Assisted Calls are measured in one-minute increments, with a one-minute minimum per call. The total charge for each completed Operator Assisted Call consists of two charge elements: fixed operator service charge, dependent on the type of billing selected (i.e., calling card, charge third party or other) and/or the completion restriction selected (i.e., station-to-station or person-to-person) and/or the manner in which the call is placed; and a variable measured charge discussed above. 1+ Dialing, 800/888 Service, Prepaid Local Access Number Cards, 800 Debit Cards, Rechargeable Calling Cards, Travel Cards and Operator Assisted Calls are rounded up to the next whole increment. DSA Telecom Calling Card calls are billed in an initial three (3) minute increment with all subsequent minutes rounded up to the nearest five (5) minute increment.

3.1.2 Where mileage bands appear in a rate table, rates for all calls are based upon the airline distance between the originating and terminating points of the call, as determined by the vertical and horizontal coordinates associated with the exchange (the area code and three digit central office code) associated with the originated and terminating numbers. If the Customer obtains access to the Company's network by a dedicated access circuit, that circuit will be assigned an exchange for

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3.6.6 Casual Calling

This service permits casual callers to make 1+ calls. Casual callers will not be charged the Company's 1+ Dialing rates set forth in Section 4.1. Instead, casual callers will be charged separate charges labeled as "Casual Calling Rates" set forth in Section 4.5 until such time as the Customer has selected a calling plan. A person will be placed in the Casual Calling category when that person's IDT America account is terminated and the person does not contact his local exchange carrier to select a new carrier and continues to make calls over the Carrier's network or when a person who has not established an account with IDT America places calls over the Carrier's network from an equal access area using an access code and until such time as Company is contacted by a new interstate interexchange carrier that the person has established new service or the customer has agreed to reinitiate service with Company.

3.6.7 Specialized Pricing Arrangements

Customized service packages and competitive pricing packages at negotiated rates may be furnished on a case-by-case basis in response to requests by Customers for proposals or for competitive bids. Service offered under this tariff provision will be provided to Customers pursuant to contract. Specialized rates or charges will be made available to similarly situated Customers on a non-discriminatory basis and be made part of this tariff.

3.6.8 Emergency Call Handling Procedures

Emergency "911" calls are not routed to Company, but are completed through the local network at no charge.

3.6.9 Promotional Offerings

The Company may, from time to time, make promotional offerings to enhance the marketing of its services. These offerings may be limited to certain dates, times and locations and will be made part of this tariff.

3.6.10 Liability for Prepaid Retail Calling Cards, DSA Telecom Calling Cards, Rechargeable Calling Cards and Travel Cards

The Customer must give the Company notice that unauthorized use of a Company Prepaid Calling Card, DSA Telecom Calling Card, Rechargeable Calling Card or Travel Card has occurred or may occur as a result of loss, theft or other reasons. For the purposes of this Section, Notice occurs when the Company receives written or oral confirmation that unauthorized use of a Prepaid Calling Card, DSA Telecom Calling Card, Rechargeable Calling Card or Travel Card has occurred or may occur as a result of loss, theft or other reason. Lost Prepaid Calling Cards, DSA Telecom Calling Cards Rechargeable Calling Cards or Travel Cards must be reported within 24 hours.

3.6.11 Travel Cards

An IDT Travel Card is an optional service made available to IDT Presubscribed 1+ Long Distance Customers. Unless otherwise noted, Travel Cards operate in the same manner described in 3.6.2; however, there is no preset dollar value on Travel Cards. Charges for calls made using an IDT Travel Card are not prepaid. Charges for calls made using an IDT Travel Card appear on the Customer's 1+ Long Distance bill.

3.6.12 DSA Telecom Calling Cards (Local Access Number and Toll Free)

(N)

This service permits the use of prepaid calling cards branded with the name "DSA Telecom" for placing calls within the State. Customers may purchase DSA Telecom Calling Cards at a variety of retail outlets or through other distribution channels. These cards are available in face values of \$5.00, \$10.00, and \$20.00 and are non-refundable.

DSA Telecom Calling Cards are accessed using a local access number or toll-free telephone number printed on the card. The caller is prompted by an automated voice response system to enter his/her Authorization Code and then to enter the terminating telephone number. The Company's processor tracks the call duration on a real time basis to determine the cost consumed. The total consumed cost for each call is deducted from the remaining balance on the card.

All calls must be charged against a card that has a sufficient balance. These cards are not rechargeable, and all calls will be interrupted when the balance on the cards reaches zero. Cardholders may dial another telephone number while using the card by depressing the pound (#) button and entering in the new telephone number.

A credit allowance for Prepaid Retail Calling Cards is applicable to calls that are interrupted due to poor transmission, one-way transmission, or involuntary disconnection of a call. A customer may also be granted credit for reaching a wrong number. To receive proper credit, the Customer must notify the Company at the designated toll-free customer service number printed on the card and furnish the called number, the trouble experienced (e.g. cut off, noisy circuit, reached wrong number, etc.) and the approximate time the call was placed.

When a call charged to a DSA Telecom Calling Card is interrupted due to cut-off, one-way transmission, or poor transmission conditions, the Customer will receive a credit equivalent of one minute. Credit allowances for do not apply for interruptions not reported promptly to the Company or interruptions that are due to failure of power, equipment or systems not provided by the Company.

Certain calls may not be completed using the DSA Telecom Calling Card. These include operator services, busy line verification service, interruption service, calls requiring time and charges, air-to-ground calls, marine/satellite calls, and calls placed via dialing a 700 or 900 number.

3.7 Minimum Call Completion Rate

A customer can expect a call completion rate (number of calls completed/number of calls attempted) of not less than 95% during peak use periods for all Feature Group D services ("1+" dialing).

DSA Telecom Calling Cards may be used as listed below, twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week, three hundred and sixty-five days a year.

The Intrastate Usage Rates for DSA Telecom Calling Cards are:

\$1.00 per minute rate.

\$1.00 per-call connection rate.

A bi-weekly service charge of \$0.79 shall be applied after its first use and every fourteen (14) days thereafter.

A surcharge of \$0.65 shall be applied to the first completed call made from a payphone using a DSA Telecom Calling Card. A surcharge of \$0.45 shall be applied to all subsequent completed calls made from a payphone using the same DSA Telecom Calling Card.

A surcharge per call of \$1.00 shall apply to all Directory Assistance calls made using a DSA Telecom Calling Card.

Dear Ms. Bayo:

By this letter, IDT America, Corp. ("IDT") hereby notifies the Florida Public Service Commission that IDT intends to offer prepaid phone card service under the brand name DSA Telecom. IDT shall offer this service under the brand name DSA Telecom *in addition to* the name IDT, under which the company is authorized to provide resold toll service, including prepaid phone card service, within the State of Florida.¹

IDT is authorized to do business as DSA Telecom pursuant to authorization granted by the Florida Secretary of State.² To the degree that IDT is required to file tariff revisions to reflect its new service offering under the DSA Telecom brand, IDT shall do so, and shall not offer any service under the DSA Telecom brand until the effective date of its tariff revisions.


Please be advised that IDT's prepaid phone card service offering under the DSA Telecom brand will have no effect on any service offered by IDT within the State of Florida: IDT will continue to offer all services presently offered. Furthermore, since DSA Telecom is simply a brand name to be used by IDT and is not a new entity, all existing Florida Public Service Commission contact information is identical for IDT and DSA Telecom.

¹ See, Order No. PSC-94-1021-FOF-TI, issued August 23, 1995 in Docket No. 940576-TI. In August 1997, pursuant to the company's request, the Commission changed the name on the certificate from International Discount Telecommunications to IDT Corporation. In March 1998, pursuant to notice by the Company, IDT Corporation assigned its license to its subsidiary, IDT America, Corp.
