Dear Pat:

In our recent telephone conference, you asked me to clarify the transfer of assets from Knight Island Utilities, Inc., to Knight Water Utility, Inc., and Island Environmental Utility, Inc., upon the Public Service Commission's approval of original certificates for the latter two entities.

Upon the PSC's approval, the Lease dated September 1, 1995, between Island Harbor Beach Club, LTD., and Charlotte Harbor Land Company, Inc., as Lessors and Knight Island Utilities, Inc., as Lessee, will be terminated as to the utility systems (except the real estate), and the Lessors will convey the water utility assets to Knight Water Utility, Inc., and the wastewater utility assets to Island Environmental Utility, Inc. The two new entities will continue to lease the real estate upon which those facilities are located.
