In addition, the Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services will be notified that the 2001 and 2002 RAFs, including statutory penalty and interest charges for the year 2001 for each certificate, should not be sent to the Comptroller's Office for collection, but that permission for the Commission to write off the uncollectible amount should be requested. If the certificate is cancelled in accordance with the Commission's Order from this recommendation, the company should be required to immediately cease and
