On April 19, 2002, Time Warner Telecom of Florida, L.P. ("Time Warner") filed a Complaint with this Commission against Verizon Florida, Inc., ("Verizon") alleging breach of Time Warner"s interconnection agreement with Verizon. Time Warner also filed a complaint in North Carolina that included similar allegations.

Subsequent to the filing of the complaints in Florida and North Carolina, Time Warner and Verizon agreed to submit the issues raised in the complaints to commercial arbitration in order to reach a resolution applicable to both states. Accordingly, Time Warner withdraws, without prejudice, the Complaint filed with this Commission on April 19, 2002.
