adoption by QuantumShift Communications, Inc. of negotiated terms of interconnection, unbundling, resale, and collocation agreement between Sprint

Communications Company L.P. and Verizon California Inc.

By letter dated July 29, 2002, Verizon Florida Inc. filed a request for acknowledgement of adoption of the interconnection, unbundling, resale, and collocation agreement entered into between Verizon CaliforniaInc. and Sprint Communications Company L.P. QuantumShift Communications, Inc. is adopting this agreement in its entirety pursuant to the Bell Atlantic/GTE Merger Conditions released by the FCC on June 16, 2000 in CC Docket No. 98-184, specifically, under paragraph 31(a) of the Most-Favored-Nation Provisions for Out-of Region and In-Region Arrangements. In paragraph 31(a), In-Region Post-Merger Arrangements, it is specified that: "Terms, conditions, and prices contained in tariffs cited in Bell Atlantic/GTE's interconnection agreements shall not be considered negotiated provisions."

By Order No. PSC-02-1174-FOF-TP, issued August 28, 2002, the Commission directed staff to administratively acknowledge all future agreements submitted to the Commission which have been adopted under merger conditions approved by the FCC.

Staff reviewed the agreement in this Docket on October 17, 2002. This Memorandum shall serve as acknowledgement of QuantumShift Communications, Inc.'s adoption of the interconnection, unbundling, resale, and collocation agreement between Verizon California Inc. and Sprint Communications Company L.P. Accordingly, with this Memorandum, the docket is hereby closed.
