Background

Aquasource Utility, Inc. (AUI) has applied to the Public Service Commission to extend its water service area in west central Lake County generally west of Lake Eustis and northwest of the City of Tavares. The Applicant's proposed service area covers about 5 acres. The area to be serviced consists of 16 residential lots, ten of which are already receiving service. The proposed service area is anticipated to consist of residential development, and the applicant has indicated that existing facilities have sufficient available capacity to service the proposed area.

Conclusion

Staff has identified no issues related to the County's Comprehensive Plan. The location of the proposed service area corresponds to Urban (7 DU/acre) on the County's Future Land Use Map.
