RE: Docket No. 020825-TC - Cancellation by Florida Public Service Commission of PATS Certificate No. 7919 issued to L.B. Computer Solutions, Inc. for violation of Rule 25-4.0161, F.A.C., Regulatory Assessment Fees, Telecommunications Companies.

ISSUE 1: Should the Commission impose a penalty of \$500 or cancel L.B. Computer Solutions, Inc.'s certificate for apparent violation of Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code, Regulatory Assessment Fees; Telecommunications Companies, incorporated by Rule 25-24.505, Florida Administrative Code, with an effective date of December 31, 2002?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes. The Commission should assess a penalty of \$500 for apparent violation of Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code, incorporated by Rule 25-24.505, Florida Administrative Code, with an effective date of December 31, 2002, if the penalty and Regulatory Assessment Fees, including statutory penalty and interest charges, are not received by the Commission within fourteen (14) calendar days after the issuance of the Consummating Order. If the company does not protest the Commission's Order, or if the penalty and Regulatory Assessment Fees, including statutory penalty and interest charges, are not received in accordance with the Commission's Order, the company's certificate should be cancelled administratively and the collection of the past due fees should
