PETITION OF FLORIDA DIGITAL NETWORK, INC., FOR EXPEDITED WAIVER OF RULE 25-4.118, FLORIDA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE

Florida Digital Network, Inc., ("FDN" or "Florida Digital") hereby petitions the Florida Public Service Commission ("FPSC" or "Commission") pursuant to Section 120.542, Florida Statutes, and Rule 28-104.004, Florida Administrative Code, to allow the transfer of customers of Mpower Communications Corp., f/k/a MGC Communications, Inc., ("Mpower") to FDN without first obtaining each subscriber's authorization and verification. In support of its petition, FDN states as follows:

- 1. FDN is an alternative local exchange carrier ("ALEC") and in-state interexchange carrier (IXC) certificated by the FPSC.¹

4. Rule 25-4.118, Florida Administrative Code, states that before submitting a preferred carrier change, carriers must verify each subscriber's authorization of the change via the methods prescribed in said rule. The requirements of Rule 25-4.118 apply to interexchange and alternative local exchange carriers by virtue of Rules 25-24.490 and 25-24.845. FDN respectfully requests a waiver of Rule 25-4.118 so that FDN may acquire the customer base of Mpower as more fully described below.

- 5. FDN has agreed to purchase certain of the Florida assets of and the rights to serve the Florida customer base of Mpower.² Mpower's business plans call for Mpower to promptly sell its Florida customer base and exit the Florida market rather than continue to serve these customers.³ FDN and Mpower desire to complete the transfer of customers from Mpower to FDN services as soon as possible.
- 6. Consistent with 47 C.F.R. § 64-1120(e), FDN will mail letters to the affected Mpower customers explaining the transfer. As that rule requires, the affected customers will be informed that they do not have an obligation to take services from FDN, but if they choose a carrier other than FDN, they must do so before the customer transfer date. The waiver requested herein will thus be temporary and for a limited purpose, as described herein. FDN requests that the waiver endure until all notified customers of Mpower who do not select a carrier other than FDN are changed to FDN services.
- 7. FDN will file the required notice with the Common Carrier Bureau of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") in accordance with 47 C.F.R. § 64-1120(e). FDN will

provide Commission staff a copy of the notification letter for its review. Once the notification letter is sent to the customers, FDN will provide a copy to the Commission.

- 8. Rule 25-4.118, Florida Administrative Code, lists as authority for the rule Section 350.127(2), Florida Statutes. The Rule lists as the laws implemented Sections 364.01, 364.19, 364.285, and 364.603, Florida Statutes.⁴
- 9. FDN's waiver request herein meets the standards of Section 120.542, Florida Statutes. The purpose of the underlying statutes at issue is, in relevant part, to ensure that basic local telecommunications services are available to all consumers, to encourage and promote fair competition in order to ensure the widest possible range of consumer choice in the provision of all telecommunications services, and to insure that a subscriber's services and changes to a subscriber's carriers are properly and fairly administered.
- 10. FDN believes that its petition is in the public interest and that alternative regulatory methods (i.e. the FCC's sanctioned notification letter to customers) will serve the same purpose in this instance as the verification requirements of Rule 25-4.118, Florida Administrative Code. FDN request that the Commission accept the draft notice letter attached as Exhibit A in lieu of the verification procedures of Section 25-4.118, Florida Administrative Code. The letter advises customers that they may choose another carrier prior to the transfer date. Customers are also given FDN's toll-free customer service numbers to call with any questions they may have about

⁴ Section 364.01 describes the legislative intent and powers and jurisdiction of the Commission; Section 364.19 grants the Commission authority to regulate the terms of contracts between telecommunications companies and their patrons; Section 364.285 grants the Commission power to impose penalties on entities subject to its jurisdiction for willful violations of lawful rules or orders of the Commission; and Section 364.603 directs the Commission to enact rules to prevent unauthorized changes in telecommunication subscribers' services.

the transaction. FDN believes the letter notification adequately serves the purpose of assuring that customers who remain with FDN genuinely wish to retain FDN as their service provider.⁵

- 11. The Commission's verification rules would not be served by requiring FDN to obtain the prior authorization and verification of every individual customer to switch from Mpower to FDN under the present circumstances. Customers who fail to timely respond to individual requests for authorization could lose their service altogether, as Mpower exits the market. Further, if the Commission does not permit this rule waiver request, the Commission may create an environment where consolidation among ALECs would be extraordinarily difficult if not completely impossible, as it would likely prove too costly for one ALEC to buy another's assets and/or customer base. FDN's petition is, therefore, consistent with the pro-consumer and procompetitive designs of Chapter 364, Florida Statutes.
- 12. Additionally, FDN asserts that it will suffer a substantial hardship if required to obtain individual customer authorizations for some 11,000 customers at once in strict adherence to Rule 24-2.118. It would be an extraordinary strain on FDN's resources -- and on the resources of even the largest of Florida's telecommunications carriers -- to contact, inform, obtain proper authorizations/verifications from for 11,000 customers all at once. FDN also asserts that a substantial hardship would be created for Mpower if Mpower had to continue to serve the affected customers when it no longer has a business plan to do so, and no longer desires to do so.
- 13. Expedited action on this waiver request is requested. The Mpower FDN purchase agreement provides that time is of the essence in the transfer of the customer base to

accommodate Mpower's business plans. Granting FDN's petition would allow FDN to provide a seamless transition to former Mpower customers, while ensuring that the affected customers clearly understand available choices. Therefore, the Commission should grant FDN's request for an expedited waiver of the Commission's authorization and verification requirements of Rule 25-4.118, Florida Administrative Code.

14. The Commission has granted expedited waiver requests similar to the instant request. See, e.g. Dockets Nos. 020473-TP and 020948-TP (concerning BellSouth's and Sprint's acquisition of certain Adelphia customers). Therefore, the Commission should grant the instant request.

15. In accordance with Rule 28-104.002, Florida Administrative Code, a copy of this petition has been mailed to the Joint Administrative Procedures Committee.

WHEREFORE and in consideration of the above, Florida Digital Network, Inc. respectfully requests the Commission grant this petition for rule waiver.
