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COMMISSION STAFF'S MOTION TO REVISE
ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURE

By and through its undersigned counsel, the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission (Staff), pursuant to Rule 106.204, Florida Administrative Code, hereby respectfully requests that the Order Establishing Procedure in this case be modified to expand the opportunity for filing Surrebuttal Testimony to include all parties in this case and Staff, and to revise and expand the date for filing Rebuttal Testimony in this case. As grounds therefore, Staff states:

1. On November 4, 2002, Order No. PSC-02-1513-PCO-TP, the Order Establishing Procedure, was issued in this Docket. Set forth in that Order were the filing and procedural dates for this case. Those dates are as follows:

2. Staff has recently determined that it will likely be beneficial for Staff's witness to file Surrebuttal Testimony in this proceeding in order to ensure a full and complete record; however, the current schedule only provides that ILECs may file Surrebuttal Testimony.

3. On Monday, February 3, 2003, Staff conducted a conference call with the parties to discuss its scheduling concerns. In order to address Staff's concern regarding Surrebuttal Testimony, while remaining true to the interest of providing a full and equal opportunity for all parties to file testimony, the following schedule revisions were discussed:

Rebuttal Testimony and Exhibits - Pricing Issues 9A, 9B, 10 (All Parties) April 18, 2003

Surrebuttal Testimony and Exhibits - Pricing Issues 9A, 9B, 10 (All Parties) June 18, 2003

As part of this proposal, the ALECs would no longer be required to file their Rebuttal Testimony and Exhibits on the pricing issues on April 4, 2003, because all Rebuttal Testimony and Exhibits on the pricing issues would now be due on April 18, 2003.

4. The parties participating on the call, Covad, BellSouth, AT&T, Verizon, and Sprint, indicated that they did not oppose Staff's motion.

5. Staff believes that these revisions will not cause disruption in the current processing of the case and will not prejudice any party to this proceeding.

Accordingly, the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission respectfully requests that the Order Establishing Procedure in this case be modified as set forth above to reflect the filing of Rebuttal Testimony and Exhibits on the Pricing Issues by all parties on April 18, 2003, and the filing of Surrebuttal Testimony and Exhibits on the Pricing Issues by all parties on June 18, 2003.

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
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
